Dear President Trump,

On behalf of the over 3,000 behavioral and social scientists who belong to the Population Association of America (<a href="www.populationassociation.org">www.populationassociation.org</a>) and almost 40 federally-supported population research centers nationwide comprising the Association of Population Centers (<a href="www.popcenters.org">www.popcenters.org</a>), we are writing to urge a timely appointment of a highly qualified director of the U.S. Census Bureau.

As you know, the current director, Mr. John Thompson, resigned recently and will be leaving his position on June 30. With Census 2020 only three years away, it is imperative that the Bureau have a highly qualified and respected director in place as soon as possible. Preparations for Census 2020 are well underway, with less than one year before a critical "dress rehearsal" in three areas of the United States. Key innovations will undergo final testing, thus allowing the Census Bureau to achieve its goal, mandated by Congress, of reducing costs while preserving accuracy of the census. Failure to fill this vacancy quickly could jeopardize the success of this 2018 End-to-End Readiness Test, delay final design decisions, and impair preparations for the 2020 Census. The Census Director also must oversee efforts to strengthen and streamline the American Community Survey (ACS), which updates the census throughout the decade, and is the only source of comparable, consistent, and timely demographic and socioeconomic data for all U.S. communities. Simply put, the need for strong, decisive leadership at the Census Bureau, particularly at this juncture, cannot be overstated.

The Presidential Appointment Efficiency and Streamlining Act of 2011 requires that the Census Bureau Director have "demonstrated ability in managing large organizations and experience in the collection, analysis, and use of statistical data." Our members rely on data disseminated by the Census Bureau to conduct their research in public, private, and academic settings. We feel strongly that in addition to meeting the legal criteria the position requires, the next Census Bureau Director should have stature in the statistical research
